



Building Community Become an RE Leader

Mission of Ministry: To provide the core of East Shore's ministry to children in the form of religious exploration. To work with the elementary children as they build their connections to Unitarian Universalism, and to guide them in their ethical and spiritual development.

RE Leaders are expected to sign a Code of Ethics and submit to a Washington State Background Check.

When performed: Sunday Mornings from September to January and/or February to June.

Team Members

- Two to Three adults on your team, parent assistants will be scheduled to help.
- You create your own schedule
- Expected to serve at least two Sundays a month

Prep Work: (Weekly)

- Read the lesson plan
- If you are the lead teacher, decide on activities based on instructions.
- Contact Curriculum coordinator if you need materials or help with preparation.
- Read updates from team members and DRE

Training and Support:

- Overview and Training in September and/or January
- Retreats and workshops on specific topics every other month
- Weekly e-mails from the RE office
- DRE will check with you often in your preferred mode of contact (i.e. telephone, e-mail, in person)
- DRE will also visit your room on Sunday mornings.

Materials:

- a curriculum with session plans (you do not need to think of what to do)
- lesson schedule and calendar for the year
- classroom stocked with your basic supplies for each lesson
- RE Library
- RE Supplies

Age groups: Preschool through 6th Grade, or ages 3-11
